



# THE SHEEP EVENT 2022

## FARM TOUR

---

**TUESDAY 26<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2022**

**08.00** assemble and board coach at the Three Counties Showground, Malvern.

**08.15** depart and transfer for the first visit of the day.

**10.00** arrive at Honeydale Farm in the Cotswold's. FarmED is an education centre based at Honeydale Farm, a regenerative demonstration farm which has a number of interconnecting micro farming businesses. **FarmED keynote exhibitor at Sheep Event 2022.**

Since 2013 Honeydale Farm has been running an 8 year crop rotation which has mobbed grazed Herbal leys at its heart. In 2022 the leys will be grazed by a small flock of New Zealand Romney Ewe Lambs and a micro diary of Fleckvieh cows and calves at foot. The sheep and cows also graze heritage wheat during the winter and move across permanent pastures during the season.



**11.45** transfer to the FarmEd restaurant for 2 course lunch with tea/coffee.

**13.30** depart for the next farm visit.

**14.00** arrive at Daylesford Organic Farm. The farm operates closed flocks of pedigree sheep that are grass fed for flavour and sold through their farm shop as part of total food mix that includes meat and poultry, fruit and veg from the market garden, bread from their bakery, and cheese, milk and yoghurt from their creamery. All ewes lamb indoors in the spring. Breeds include Lley, Cotswolds, Ryelands and Kerry Hill. Tour of the stock and fields by trailer.

**16.00** return to the Three Counties Showground.



**17.30** arrive.
